The Bilin Language by Leo Reinisch Dictionary of Blin Language, Vienna 1887

This is a Blin German dictionary, written by Prof. Leo Reinisch in 1887. The book has about 3500 words (426 pages), with explanations and comparable words in many languages like Ge'ez, Tigrigna, Tigre, Amharic, Arabic, Agaw and others. It was published in copies of paperback and hard cover. The book has been and still is very helpful for researchers who study the Blin language. The importance of this book for the development of the Blin language is also very high, as it contains some Blin words which are extinct or almost extinct at the present time.
